Scholarship benefits

Selection criteria

Scholarship holders will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Be an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident;
- Be a Tennis Australia Trainee coach member (minimum);
- Must be 18 years or over at the time of application;
- Currently coaching full time;
- Commitment to the sport of tennis.

If no suitable scholarship applications are received during the application period, Tennis Australia reserves the right not to offer a scholarship. Tennis Australia's decision regarding the award of the scholarships will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Note: There are a limited number of scholarships available for each coaching course or program.
